RULES

- 1) National Federation of High School Baseball Rules will apply unless otherwise stated below.
- 2) Slaughter rule: 15 runs after 2 innings, 12 runs after 3 innings 10 runs after 4 innings 8 after 5.
- 3) Last out runs for catcher at any time. A team can elect to bat as many players as it so desires, 9 up to its entire line-up. No pitching rule.
- 4) Teams will be seeded after 2 games played, but all will be eligible on Sunday for the championship round. Games start at noon Friday.
- 5) 1hr 45 min time limit on games. If the score is tied after the time limit or 7th inning each team will receive ½ game win/loss. Tie Breaker Parameters: 1) Head to Head 2) Best Record 3) Least Runs Allowed 4) Most runs scored 5) Coin Flip.
- 6) Fields are 60/90 for U14, U15, and U16 with U13 being 54x80.

ENTRIES, DOCUMENT & POLICIES

- 1) Each team must have submitted a completed entry form with the entrance fee of \$425.00 tournament. \$375.00 Multiple Teams.
- 2) Each team is responsible for its own insurance. Team managers upon checking in must show proof of insurance.
- 3) Withdrawing: Teams canceling prior to 60 days from any tournament are entitled to a FULL REFUND of entry fee. Teams canceling 59 days to 31 days before a tournament are entitled to a 75% REFUND of entry fee. Teams canceling 30 days or less prior to the start of a tournament WILL NOT RECEIVE ANY REFUND.
- 4) Team trophies for first and second place.

RAIN POLICY/ Tournament Information Phone Number

- 1) If a tournament is completely rained out and NO games are played then 75% refund of the entry fee received shall be refunded.
- 2) The TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR reserves the right to reduce the schedule of games based on field conditions. **This would only take place once it has been determined that there is NO possible way to finish the published format due to weather or field conditions.**
- 3) NO REFUND will be given to any team playing at least one game regardless of any tournament format.
- 4) Team managers are responsible for staying in contact with the tournament director.

- 5) Our goal for each tournament is to provide 3 games for each team. Once we have provided 3 games for each team, if the Championship round is canceled for any reason, the champion and runner up will be determined using the tie breaker rules. If a game is rained out and the decision is made to play the game at a later date game will continue where it was left off.
- 6) Please be aware that the weather conditions and your team's advancement to the championship round on Sunday, may pose the possibility of playing three games in one day.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY & TEAM ROSTERS

- 1) Age cutoff date for each player is May 1st. Birth certificates must be available upon request. Any team who misrepresents the age of any player on their team will be eliminated from the tournament, banned from any further tournaments and will forfeit any tournament fees received by Western Kiwanis
- 2) ROSTERS: All managers must supply a copy of their roster complete with jersey numbers and birth dates upon checking in to the tournament director or tournament site coordinator. Please include Coaches names.
- 3) Each team will receive 4 Coaches Passes.

SPORTSMANSHIP

- 1) It is the responsibility of the team manager to control your players **and your fans**. Remind your players and fans to show sportsmanship at all times. Failure to show sportsmanship by either your team or fans will result in your team being asked to leave the tournament and NO refunds will be given.
- 2) **Use of foul language is strictly prohibited. Any manager, coach, player or fan using foul language will be ejected from the game they are participating in and the tournament.**

MISCELLANEOUS

- 1) **No carry-ins allowed. Anyone possessing carry-ins will be ejected from Nash Park. Team are allowed 1(ONE) TEAM COOLER.**
- 2) Gate Fee per day of \$5 for adults \$3 for students. Weekend Pass Fri-Sun \$12 for adults, \$7 for students, Sat-Sun \$8 for adults, \$5 for students. **Coaches Please Remind Your Fans & Families Nash Park Has Gate Fee AND NOT CARRY IN POLICY.**
- 3) Games results will be posted at the Nash Park Gate.
- 4) Umpires will be provided by the Kenosha Officials Association, in conjunction with, guest umpires from surrounding communities. Two umpires will be used whenever possible.
